

Keystone Sable in 1:54.4 win at Scioto

Keystone Sable, a 5-year-old Western Hanover mare owned and trained by Ronald D. Barker, paced the fastest mile on Thursday at Scioto Downs.

Bettors made the 5-year-old pacing mare the 2-1 favorite in the field of 10 horses. Driver Chris Page sent her to the front at the start of the race and she won by an impressive 7-3/4 lengths in 1:54.4.

It was her sixth win in 18 starts during the 2008 racing season and brought her earnings to almost \$10,000 this year.

Second was Nucksrosey and third was Sandy's Noble Star.

This Saturday Scioto Downs is hosting a Belmont Patio Party to allow patrons to watch and wager on Big Brown's attempt to win the Triple Crown. The live racing at Scioto Downs on Saturday has a special 5:30 p.m. post time.
